

## Penn State Renewable Energy Teacher Summer Workshop

July 10-14, 2017



- ◆ Spend a week at University Park learning about current bioenergy research from nationally recognized faculty. Participate in inquiry-based classroom activities based on the work being done by university scientists and engineers. These classroom research projects are aligned with state and national standards.
- ◆ Topics include sustainability, biofuels and bioproducts. This workshop is a STEM integrated experience, providing resources and skills to help teachers work with their colleagues to implement these concepts into their classroom.
- ◆ Middle and high school teachers receive housing, meals, travel expenses, classroom materials, and a \$300 stipend for attending the workshop. Transportation to field trip sites is also provided.
